The Hot Club of Baltimore, led by acclaimed guitarist Michael Joseph Harris, performs inspired arrangements of the Django Reinhardt repertoire, French Gypsy waltzes, and traditional Jazz. The ensemble boasts a variety of configurations including an instrumental trio of two guitars and upright bass, a classic quintet with violin or clarinet, and a late 40's version adding piano, drums, and horns. ## Todd Marcus Quartet | Safe & Sound Private Concert



Bass clarinetist/composer Todd Marcus is one of the few jazz artists worldwide to focus their work primarily on the bass clarinet. His playing has carved out a unique voice for the instrument in modern jazz with music that swings and grooves with both a fiery and introspective intensity but also maintains a strong lyrical sensibility. Self-taught in jazz theory and composition, Marcus' compositions draw largely on straight-ahead jazz and classical influences but over recent years have also increasingly explored the Middle-Eastern sounds from his Egyptian-American heritage. - An out of town or state winner may gift their performance to a local resident. Please advise GMF.
- The artist/band must be able to perform safely outside on the sidewalk or winner's front/back yard.
- The artist/band may need access to electric/power outlet, etc.
- The schedule will be coordinated directly with the artist/band at a mutually convenient day/time based on the artist/band's availability through April 2021.
- GMF will connect the winner and performer with each other's contact information.
- In the event of poor weather concerts will be rescheduled.
